Then the coach will pick us up and take us to board the ship Caversham Lady for our 3 hour river cruise with a cream tea on board. Meandering through Wind in the Willows country and passing through Mapledurham Lock and villages of Pangbourne and Whitchurch. We leave for home approx 5pm.
